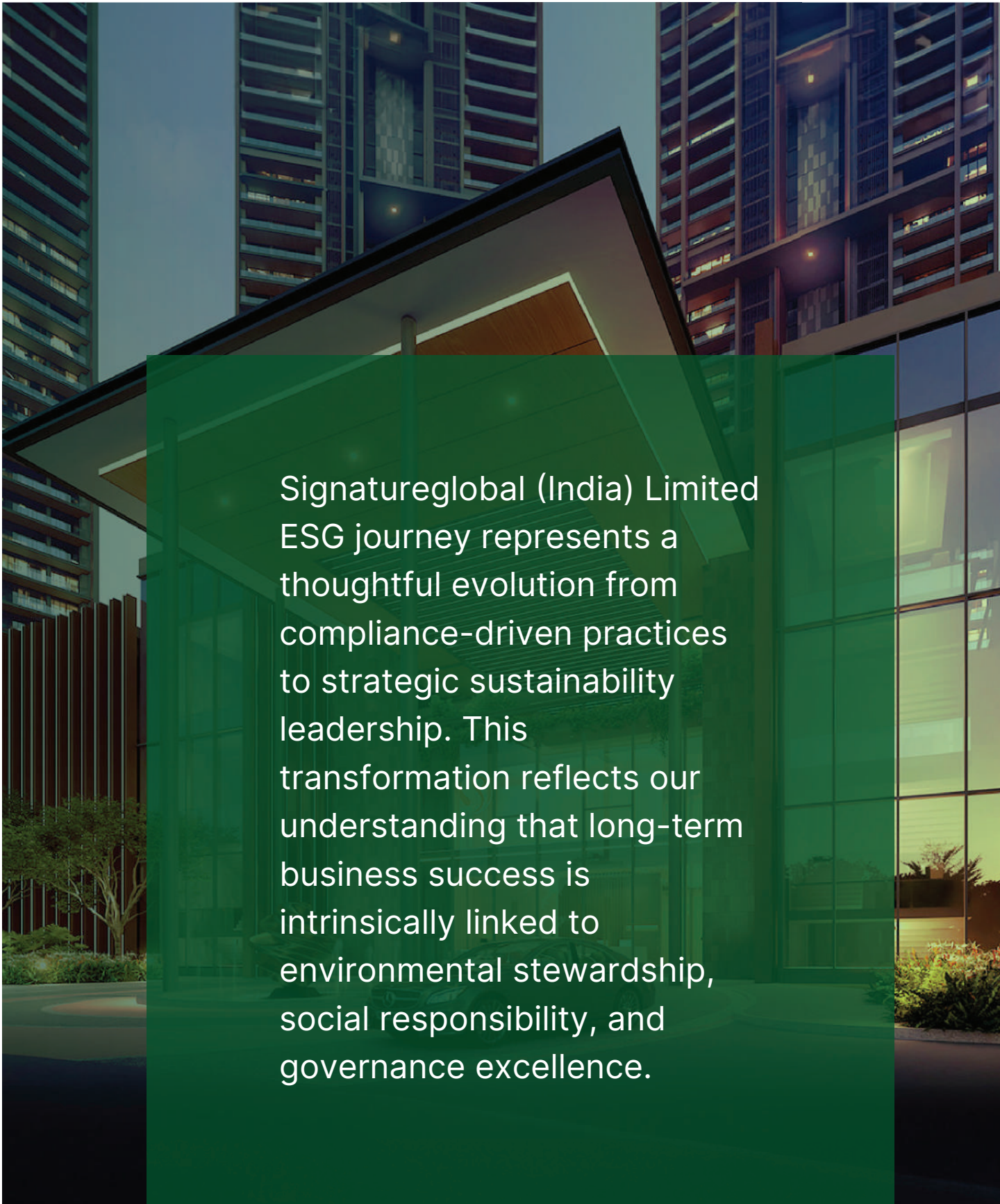

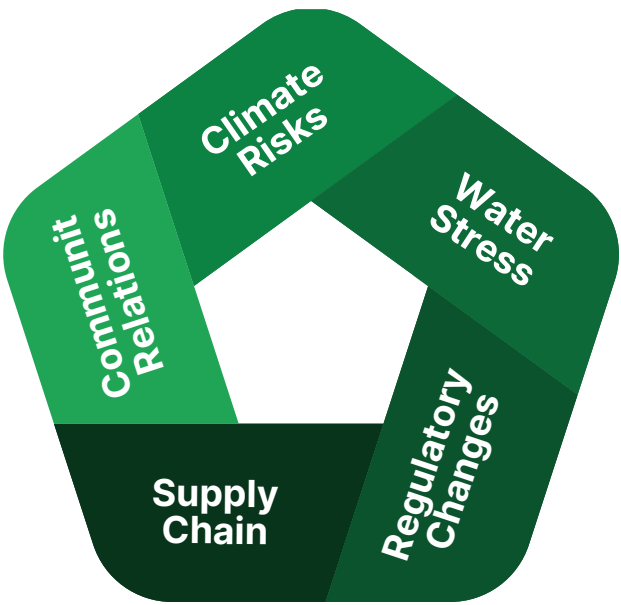

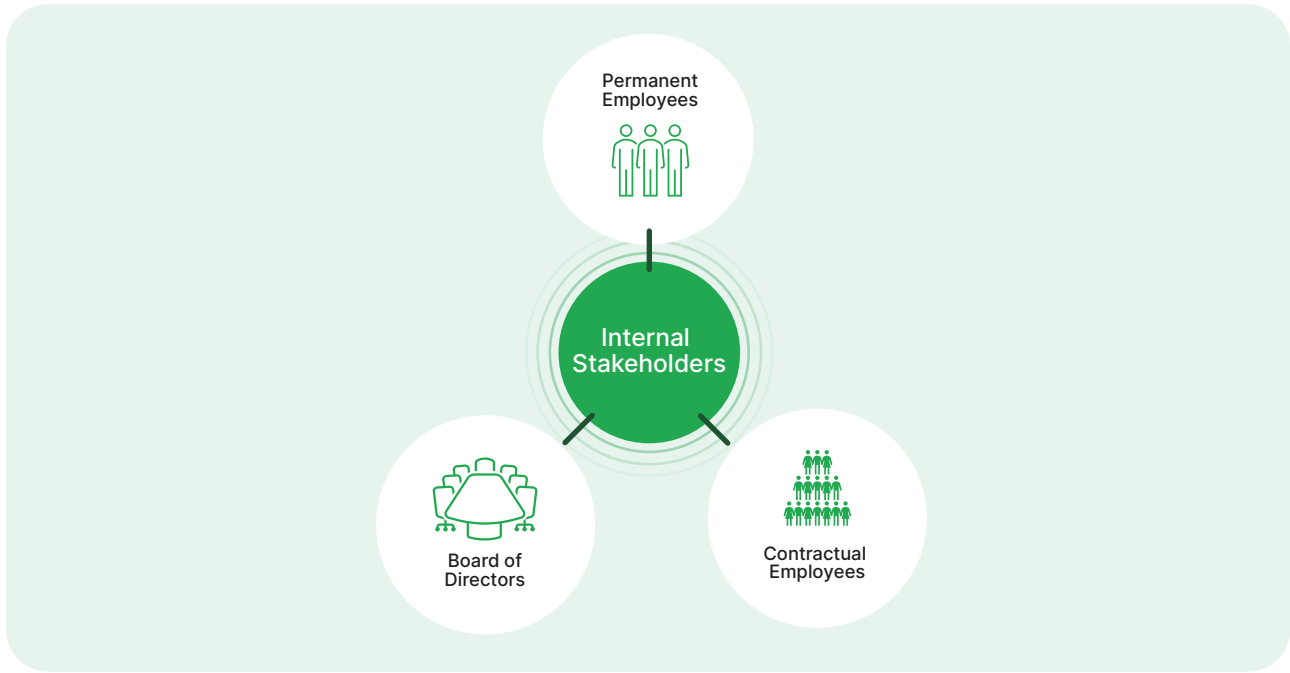
Stakeholder Mapping & Engagement
